Objectives of IIPC

- To diagnose and assess the problems being faced by the organizations in different functional areas and design appropriate methods approaches to address those specific problems of the organization.
- To assess the training needs of organization in different functional areas and accordingly design suitable training programmes to inculcate the latest concepts and techniques in the relevant field.
- To facilitate exchange of faculty between institute and organization i.e. getting professional from industry as visiting faculty for short or long periods and deputation of faculty to industry to gain industrial experience and/or work on projects in industry.
- To encourage and facilitate collaborative research involving faculty members, research scholars, students and industry professionals.
- To arrange industrial visit and training for students and identify student project work in industries.
- Curriculum development-associating experts from industry in curriculum planning and reviews.
- Personality development workshops for students relating with soft skills (Communication skills/personality development).
